St. Alphonsa - India's new saint will be canonised today in Rome by Pope Benedict. We rejoice with the Indian Community in our Parish, some of whom come from the same area as St. Alphonsa.

She was born Anna Muttathupadath on 19th August 1910 in Kudamaloor in Kerala. She entered the Clarist Convent in 1927 and was professed in 1936. She endured much sickness and pain during her life but accepted this suffering cheerfully. She died on 28th July 1946. School children were her first devotees and they received many favours through her intercession.
